

## What is Expected of You as an Ambassador

### As a Niagara Club Member:

- **Remember**, you are not only an Ambassador for the Niagara club, but also for your country and for Friendship Force.

### As a Guest:

- **Be** considerate of limited resources. For example, your hosts' hot water supply may not equal what you are accustomed to at home.
- **Offer** to take your hosts out for a meal.
- **Take** a present for your host and a variety of small gifts for people you meet. It is appropriate to take a gift representative of and made in Canada
- **Take** along photos of your home, family and community to share with your hosts so they have a better understanding of you.
- **If** you have a problem, tactfully raise the matter with your Host. If this fails, contact your ED. But remember, you are a guest and must respect your host's customs and habits.

### As a Good Ambassador:

- **On** an Exchange, punctuality is important.
- **Have** a positive, open mind. You are a guest in a foreign country,
- **Expect** to try new ideas, new food and have fun.
- **Be** independent. Enjoy the activities your hosts have planned for you, but be able to amuse yourself part of the time.
- **Be** prepared to participate in household routines and activities.
